



Mahogany	Mahogany are the large, deciduous timer family trees known for their attractive and durable wood that is often used for furniture, flooring, cabinetry, boatbuilding, musical instruments and other decorative or structural purposes. Mahogany wood contains compounds that are natural repellents to insects, making them natural insecticides and insect repellents.	12-15 Yrs	Long term	After 12 years: 25-40 cubic feet
Mango	Mango is considered as the King of fruits in India due to its wide adaptability, high nutritive value, richness in varieties and delicious taste.	2-3 yrs	Yearly	2nd-3rd year - 25-50 fruits/plant 3rd-7th year - 50-100 fruits/plant 7th -10th year - 100-300 fruits/plant 10th Year onwards - 300-600 fruits/plant
Guava	Popularly known as 'apple of tropics' or 'poor man's apple' with a rich source of vitamin C and pectin and moderate source of vitamin B, calcium, iron and phosphorus. The most recommended fruit for diabetes prevention and control.	1.5-2 yrs	Half-Yearly	2nd - 4th year - 50-75 fruits/plant 5th year onwards - 100-200 fruits/plant
Avocado	A native of tropical America is the most nutritious fruit and the pulp is rich in proteins and fat and low in carbohydrates.	3-4 yrs	Yearly / Half-Yearly	4th-6th year - 100+ fruits/plant 6th year onwards - up to 500 fruits/plant















Water Apple	Water apple, also known as watery rose apple or simply, rose apple commonly referred to as "Chambakka" or "Pani Seb" in Hindi, "Gulaabijamikaayalu" in Telugu. Water apple confers several benefits for human health and is prized for its therapeutic applications for treating various ailments, including heart conditions, liver disorders, headaches, fever treatments, skin conditions, diabetes and cancer prevention.	2-2.5 yrs	Half-Yearly	After 4 years - 15-20 kgs/plant
Litchi	A seasonal fruit widely cultivated in many countries. High nutritional value, attractive colour and delicious taste make this fruit a popular choice. Litchi spoils quickly after it's been harvested, so it is often processed and stored as dried fruits, juices, and wines, which effectively increases its shelf life. Litchi has the potential to be used in industries like food, cosmetics, pharmaceuticals, and chemical industries	2-3 yrs	Half-Yearly	After 4 years - 15-20 kgs/plant
Coconut	The coconut palm is a long-lived plant; it has a single trunk, 20-30 meter tall. The coconut palm is perhaps the widest-grown palm in the world. The tree is considered the most useful tree in the tropics because it provides everything needed to sustain life – The Kalpa Vriksha!	4-5 yrs	Quarterly	5th year - 25-50 nuts/plant 6th year onwards - 100 nuts/plant and above
